

# June 2024 European elections: insights from voters



## 60% say they are interested in the June elections: +3 pp since autumn 2023, +11 pp since spring 2019

QA13. The next European elections will be held in June 2024. How interested or not would you say you are in these elections? (EU27) (%)




QA13 The next European elections will be held in June 2024. How interested or not would you say you are in these elections? (% - Total 'Interested')





## 53% of EU citizens say it is important to vote in European elections An increase of 6 points compared to September-October 2023





Likelihood to vote in 2019 and 2024 compared to actual turnout of 2019 European elections (%)






QA21.4. In view of the upcoming European elections, to what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statements? :-The current international context makes voting even more important (EU27) (%)


## Main priority topics for the EP: evolution between November 2021 and November 2023





## 41% of EU citizens have a positive image of the EP, a 5 point increase compared to autumn 2023 and highest result since first measured


QA1 In general, do you have a very positive, fairly positive, neutral, fairly negative or very negative image of the European Parliament? (% - EU)

## In all countries, at least two thirds have either a positive or a neutral image of the EP




## 56% of EU citizens would like the EP to play a more important role It is 5 points higher than in spring 2019, 3 points more than in autumn 2023

## In all Member States but one a majority would like to see the EP play a more important role Czechia is the only exception







## 47% have a positive image of the EU, a proportion that has remained high following the pandemic and Russia's invasion of Ukraine



## Results vary greatly between countries, positive image is highest in Portugal, Ireland and Sweden; lowest in France, Austria and Czechia








QA7. Would you say the actions of the EU have an impact on your daily life? (EU27) (%)














## Four in ten Europeans think the EU's role in the world has become more important in the past years

## There are large variations, the perception of a more important role for the EU is highest in Sweden, Portugal and Denmark








